## **Volunteering Opportunities**



### **Bathroom Remodel Project**

As many know, the restrooms downstairs are outdated and not easily accessible. For these reasons, our next major improvement project is to remodel the bathrooms and make them ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliant. Below is the proposed floor plan for the bathrooms. A year ago, our architect estimated the cost for this project to be around \$30,000. As of July 31st, there is \$11,492 in the Special Fund for this project.
